

FINAL REGULATIONS ZONE 3 – ANDALUSIA



You can represent Spain in the World Final in Malaysia - Johor Bahru

- Amateur golfers aged 16 and over may participate. If the winner and representative of the Spanish team is under 18 years of age, they must be accompanied by an adult to the World Final.
- A professional player may participate, but with the allocation of an amateur handicap from the RFEG.
- Players who are foreign nationals but hold a valid golf license issued by the Royal Spanish Golf Federation (RFEG) and **are permanent residents of Spain or hold a Spanish passport** will be eligible to participate. (For this edition of Malaysia, Andorran players will be considered Spanish and must hold a valid RFEG golf license.)
- Any player participating in the Zone 3 Final must have a valid license issued by the RFEG.
- The handicap for results will be a maximum of 25.4 for both gentlemen and ladies.
- **The game format will be Medal Play Handicap + 4 maximum.**
 - (on par 3, maximum 7 strokes)
 - (on par 4, maximum 8 strokes)
 - ((on par 5, maximum 9 strokes)
- **In case of a tie:** if 2 or more players are tied by strokes, the player with the LOWEST PLAYING HANDICAP will win. If the playing handicap is the same, a playoff hole will be played.
- There are no distinct categories of gentlemen and ladies.
- Only in the 5th category: if the player who wins a regional test drops to a lower category, the next player will qualify, provided that this player was in the 5th category.
- In all 5 categories: if the first two ranked players in a regional test cannot attend the Zone Final, their place will be taken by the next ranked player who will have the right to play in the Zone Final, but not to win the trophy.
- In all 5 categories: if the champion of their Zone cannot attend the National Grand Final in Madrid, WITH ALL EXPENSES PAID, their place would be taken by the runner-up and so on.
- All tee-offs for the Men will be from Yellows, not allowing departures from Blues or Reds.
- All women's tee-offs will start from Reds.
- The handicap categories are:

Category 1	Category 2	Category 3	Category 4	Category 5
Handicap Plus - 5,4	Handicap 5,5 - 10,4	Handicap 10,5 - 15,4	Handicap 15,5 - 20,4	Handicap 20,5 - 25,4

- If a player were to qualify in one category and then change categories over the course of several months, the Zone 3 Final would be played in the category they are in on August 12th.
- Attendance at the Zone 3 Final will cost €95 (see program).
- **The 5 winners of the Zone 3 Final will attend, with all expenses paid, the National Grand Final to be held in Madrid on September 4th and 5th.**
- **The following will attend the National Grand Final in Madrid:**
 - The 5 winners from the Catalonia Zone (one per category)
 - The 5 winners from the Madrid - Castillas Zone (one per category)
 - The 5 winners from the Andalusia Zone (one per category)
 - The 5 winners from the Balearic Islands Zone (one per category)
- **From the National Grand Final in Madrid, the 5 members of the National Team that will represent Spain in the 32nd Edition of the World Final in Malaysia - Johor 2026 will be selected.**
- **Attendance at the National Final in Madrid (Retamares Golf Club) will be fully paid (except for the trip)**
- **Attendance at the World Final in Malaysia - Johor will be fully paid.**
- The rules of the game will be the permanent rules of the RFEG and the local rules of each field.
- The sports management of WAGC Spain reserves the right to change the regulations or suspend any event or vary any point of these regulations, due to organizational needs.
